ONSITE EXPLORING CERTIFICATIONS

Professionals and volunteers of all tenures and titles are invited to participate in the Exploring Certification training courses. This certification is a 3-part course that requires the completion of pre-course work, classroom instruction, and post-course work. Certifications are specifically designed for professionals and volunteers who are interested in growing the Exploring program.

The national Exploring team, along with the national membership growth coaches, will work with each area director to schedule one (1) Exploring certification in each area. One council in each area will be asked to serve as the host. This is a free course, however a nominal fee of \$15 per person may be collected for lunch and snacks.
